

**Congregational Listening**  
*Potential Interview Questions*

1. Think about your entire time with \_\_\_\_\_ Church. Remember when you felt most energized and motivated about your participation. Describe the circumstances. Who was involved? How did you feel? What was happening?
  
2. Don't be "humble" – this is important information: What are your most valuable contributions to \_\_\_\_\_ Church (e.g. your personality, your perspectives, your skills/gifts, your activities)?
  
3. What are the most important ways \_\_\_\_\_ Church has contributed to your life? Who or what has made a difference? How did it affect you?
  
4. What have been the most important spiritual experiences, lessons in belief, or steps of faith for you at \_\_\_\_\_ Church? Describe what and how they happened. What was most helpful?
  
5. Identify the main characteristics or ways of life that make \_\_\_\_\_ Church unique. What is most important about \_\_\_\_\_ Church?
  
6. Make three wishes for the future of \_\_\_\_\_ Church.
